1. Parent-Form Teacher Conference

This conference serves as a platform for form teachers and parents of their form class to discuss the holistic development progress of their children so as to support their learning needs. Parents will also receive their child's Mid-Year Progress Report from their child's form teacher during the meeting. Students will be required to accompany their parents to meet with their teachers. Students are to be attired in full school uniform.
